Key People

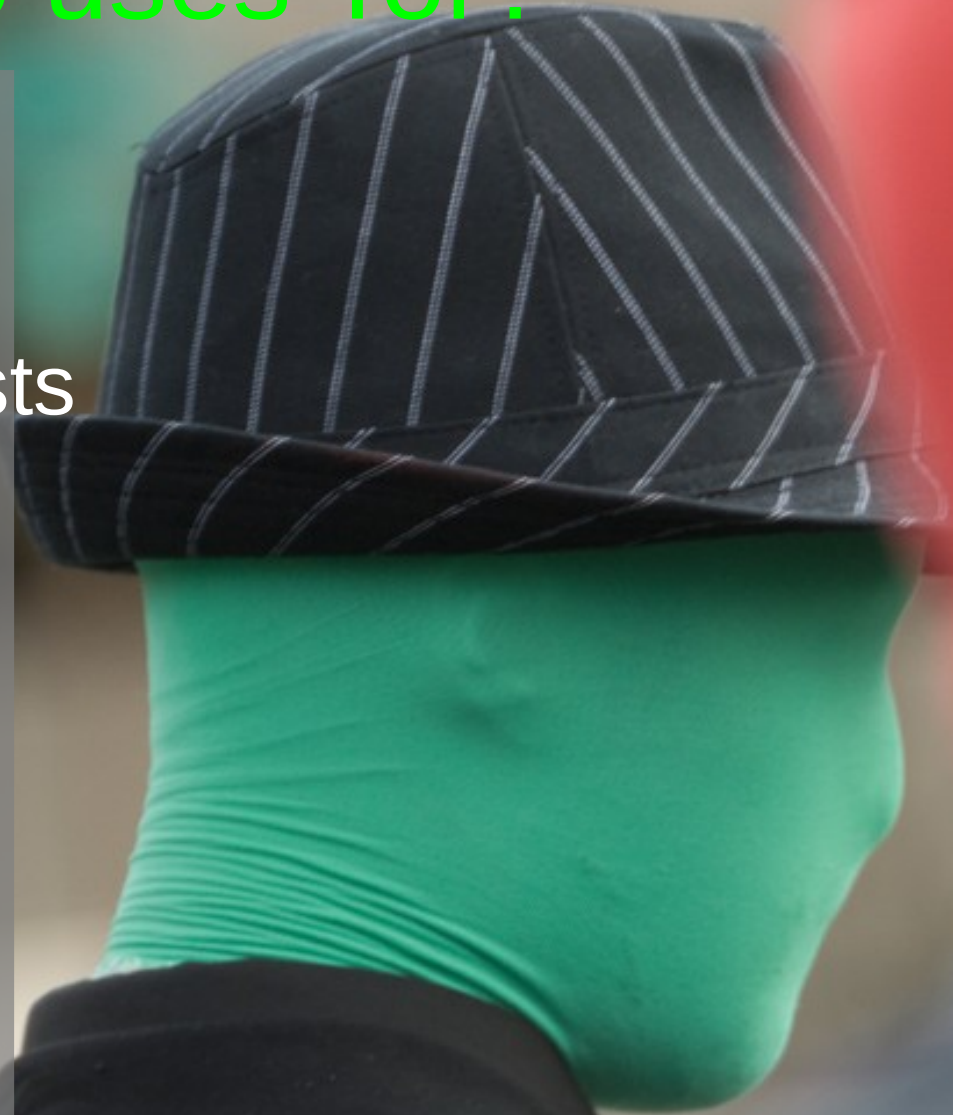
- Roger Dingledine, Project Leader
